M.Com. (Commerce/Applied Economics) 60 seats each	<ul> <li>For M.Com. Commerce – B.Com. / B.Com. (Hons) Gen/OBC – 48% and SC/ST – 43%</li> <li>For M.Com. Applied Economics – B.Com. / B.Com. (Hons)/ BBA/ B.A. with Economics in Final Year of Graduation Gen/OBC – 45% and SC/ST – 40%</li> <li>For Faculty of Arts (PG Courses – M.A. Economics/ English/ Hindi/ Sociology):         <ul> <li>In case the candidate seeks admission in the subject, which he/she has studied in all the three years of graduation the eligibility will be minimum 45% of marks.</li> <li>In case the candidate seeks admission in the subject, which he/she has studied in the first two years of graduation but not in the final year, the eligibility will be minimum 55% of marks.</li> <li>In case the candidate seeks admission in the subject which he/she has not studied in any year of graduation, eligibility will be minimum 60% of marks.</li> <li>In case the eligibility in the subject is "Any Graduate" the candidate has to obtain minimum 50% of marks in graduation. B. P. Ed. – 50 Seats	Passed 10+2+3 with Physical Education as a subject (min 45% marks) or Passed 10+2+3 with 50% marks any discipline having participated in any college / state/ national sports recognized by Govt. of India. The age of candidate as on 1st July must not be more than 25 Years as per 10th certificate.
