<b>LL.B.</b> Regular – 320	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Passed 10+2+3 system from any University recognized by UGC.</li> <li>The age limit for admission is as per rules of Lucknow University &amp; Bar Council of India.</li> <li>Minimum %age of marks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Gen – 45%*, OBC – Lucknow University Rules* and SC/ST – 40%*</li> <li>(*Based on total marks of all subjects)</li> </ul> </li> <li>2% marks shall be deducted for each gap year from the percentage of qualifying degree subject to maximum gap of three years.</li> </ol>
