For Faculty of Arts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In case the candidate seeks admission in the subject, which he/she has studied in the all three years of graduation the eligibility will be minimum 45% of marks. • In case the candidate seeks admission in the subject, which he/she has studied in the first two years of graduation but not in the final year, the eligibility will be minimum 55% of marks. • In case the candidate seeks admission in the subject which he/she has not studied in any year of graduation, eligibility will be minimum 60% of marks. • In case the eligibility in the subject is "Any Graduate" the candidate has to obtain minimum 50% of marks in graduation. This applies to subjects which are not available in University of Lucknow at graduation level.
